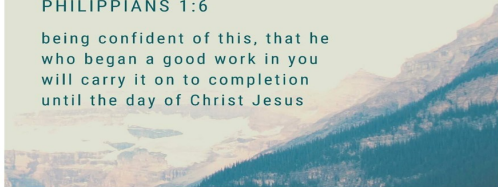

Friday 14 March

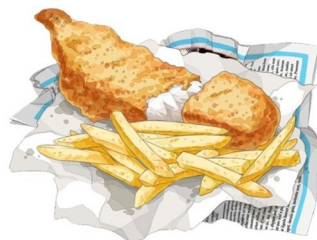
Volunteers are needed for the big clean up in church. All help is greatly appreciated.

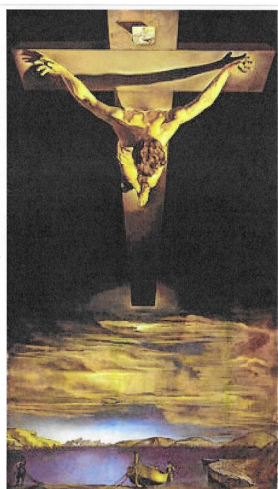

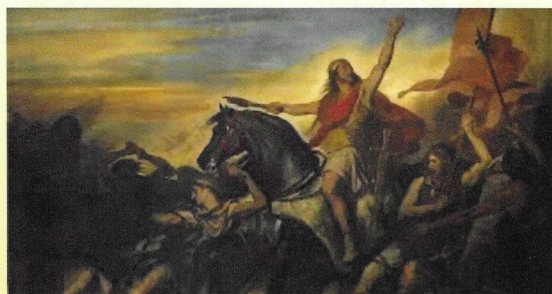

BRF MINISTRIES BIBLE READING NOTES

BRF Ministries publish a range of Bible reading notes to encourage people to read a short passage of the Bible each day with notes that help them understand the passage and apply it to their lives.
